Installed several drainage swales throughout the community (ongoing project as needed.)

Fencing installed along QHD to discourage cut-through's and wear on the lawns.

2020 Phase 1 of Grasscrete installed in common area alley in upper QHD, behind townhomes 1220-1224 QHD.

Repaired trench drains behind 1237-1249 QHD, removed clogs.

French drains installed in common area in lower QHD, behind townhomes.

Phase 2 of Grasscrete installed in lower QHD.

Ongoing projects

Dartmouth Road/QHD common area erosion/stormwater management

Completed steps:

Q1, 2021 Interviewed several consultants for recommendations for erosion area between townhomes on QHD and Dartmouth Road. Kimley Horn selected.

May 2021 Stormwater management/erosion mitigation study commissioned and completed by Kimley Horn. Reviewed at July BoD meeting.

Pending steps:

Oct/Nov RFP responses reviewed and contract awarded.

Late 2021-Q1 2022 Work on Phase 1 recommendations completed PROVIDED costs are in line with initial estimates and guidance from Kimley Horn.

Phase 1 recommendations include:

- 1. Regrading of area around storm drain inlet at top of hill to maximize water capture.
- 2. Remove and replace trench drain inlets behind townhomes on QHD. Regrade to depress inlets to increase flow captured and drained.
- 3. Reroute some of the trench drains on QHD to drain to inlet at southern end of trench.
- 4. Reinforce area immediately surrounding storm drain with a stone blanket to address erosion. Plant a landscape buffer to improve aesthetics.

Follow-on phases will be defined once the impact of Phase 1 on drainage is assessed.
